MDEQ has granted the City of Flowood a permit to discharge Storm water into state waters. The permit requires the development and implementation of a storm water Program.

- 1) Public Education and Outreach
- 2) Public Participation and Involvement
- 3) Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination
- 4) Construction Site Runoff Control
- 5) Post Construction Runoff Control
- 6) Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping
